BMX Chb-CHAMPIONSHIP 2022

The Alpe-Adria-BMX Cup and Alpe-Adria BMX Club Championship will be executed in 12 runs. All riders with a valid BMX license are permitted for participation. The Alpe-Adria-BMX Cup and Alpe-Adria BMX Club Championship 2022 will be freely advertised. Every participating rider (even if he/she is not from Austria, Hungary, Slovenia or Italy), will get counted in the final ranking.

- □ In **Mühlen**, the Dr. Auer BMX Night Race takes place at **27.08.2022**. Because of that, all open-races will be executed on Saturday instead of Sunday. A standalone announcement for the **Dr. Auer BMX Night Race** will be available as well.
- An EXTRA INFO will be sent out for amateur classes at races in Italy!
- Open races will be executed on Saturday in Vösendorf.
- ➡ Practice (free & gate) must be split into the 2 groups mentioned below: "riders under 13 years", "riders 13 years & over"

- The team-manager meeting has to take place after the official training and before the race starts, so riders that are team manager as well has the opportunity to attend the meeting
- □ On racedays, there has to be at least one medically QUALIFIED & trained person for emergency cases in addition to the regular ambulance employees, which overviews the racing action.
- COVID Practice (free & gate) must be split into 3 4 groups if the groups are too large. The chief commissaire and race director decide on site.

Girls ride together with boys; but one class lower than their regular age! MTB / 4X rider are competing in cruiser class. (valid 4X / MTB/ BMX license needed for insurance purpose)

\* Men 17+ OPEN – only the following license-categories are permitted for start: Elite Men, Junior Men, Men 17 – 24, Men 25 – 29, Men 30+

If there are less than five riders in one class, they'll get consolidated with the next higher group in classification.

The consolidated classes **won't be rated** separately at the daily ranking.

If there are less than 5 riders in Men 17+ OPEN, the class gets consolidates with Boys 15 – 16.

If there are less than 5 riders in the category Cruiser -29 or Cruiser 30+, the classes will get consolidated

If the total amount of riders in Women 17+ is lower than five, the class gets consolidated with Boys 15/16.

In Rivignano, the category Men 17+ OPEN will be split into the classes "Men 17+ AlpeAdria" and an additional "Championship"-class. The pro-line has to be ridden in the

championship category and no points can be scored for the overall Alpe-Adria ranking. "Men 17+ AlpeAdria" is going to ride the challenge line. Only rides with a valid Jr./Elite Men license are permitted to participate in the championship-category. Each rider can choose in which category he/she wants to participate as long as the license requirements are fulfilled - however, no points can be scored for the overall Alpe-Adria ranking.

Participation fee for championship-categories are set individually by the organizer.

### **RULES OF COMPETITION**

All valid 2022 UCI competition rules come into effect.

Every rider has to wear his/her national or international number. (color of number plate and digit in accordance with official UCI reglement). Should there be the case, that two riders on a Alpe-Adria event do have the same numbers, the rider from the country the race takes place has to put the prefix of his / her country in front of the number. (prefixes are specified below)

## (I = Italy, A = Austria, H = Hungary, S = Slovenia, G = Germany)

The organizer of the event has to provide the needed prefix for the numberplate of the country the race takes place in!

Every rider must have a UCI conform sideplate with his/her number, properly attached to his/her bike.

A second chief-commisaire from austria has to be present at every Alpe-Adria race.

SPD pedals are admitted from vintage 2009.

When using SPD pedals, the rider has to prove that he/she is able to get in and out at the pedals on his/her own, whenever an official requests this.

At every executed race, a daily ranking of every class has to be provided public and officially.

After hang-up of the daily ranking, there is a protest time of 15 minutes. The day rankings in the according categories are binding to the final ranking.

All Alpe-Adria events are generally run with mixed motos.

#### Pro section rules:

If there is a pro-section available on the track, Men 17+ OPEN have to ride there. However, other categories are not permitted to ride on the pro section.

### **Exceptions:**

If Men 17+ and Boys 15 - 16 get consolidated, the decision if the pro line or challenge line have to be ridden will be made during the team manager meeting.

Special treatment in Rivignano: Men 17+ Alpe Adria goes for the challenge-line. The championship-category has to ride the pro-line.

If it's decided during the team-manager-meeting that the pro-line is closed (weather conditions, rain, wind and so on), this decision affects all riders – no free line choice pro/challenge for 17+!

At the race Vösendorf and Maribor, the team-manager needs to pre-sign all athletes until 3 days before official race-date. If that's not the case, there is still the possibility to register on raceday. For the higher amount of work, an additional fee as high as 5€ needs to be paid. The registration / sign-in / announcement of presence is done without exceptions just by the team manager. Pre-registered riders just have to pay if they are present on raceday.

At the race Sopron, Mühlen, Gencsapati and Ljubljana, the team-manager needs to pre-sign all athletes until 5 days before official race-date. If that's not the case, there is still the possibility to register on raceday. For the higher amount of work, an additional fee as high as 10 € needs to be paid. The registration / sign-in / announcement of presence is done without exceptions just by the team manager. Pre-registered riders just have to pay if they are present on raceday.

### □ The daily amount of prize money has to be handed out to the riders on raceday.

A copy of the publicly provided daily ranking and a copy of the registration list have to be handed over immediately after the race to Andreas Kogler sen. (responsible for overall ranking)

## Alpe-Adria-BMX Championship FINAL RANKING

A final ranking for the Alpe-Adria-BMX-Cup will just be set up if there are at least 3 qualified riders.

Only the 10 best race results will be counted per rider. That means that the two worst results will be discarded. If a rider does not participate at a race (e.g. 0 points), it also counts as a discarded result.

If a race gets cancelled, it doesn't count as discardable result.

To appear in the final ranking, a rider has to participate on at least 4 races without DNS.

All participants are in accordance of their rank classified and awarded.

The whole amount of points is decisive.

The bigger amount of first places

The bigger amount of second places a.s.o.

The bigger amount of participated races

The best placements in the motos.

For a final ranking at least 50% of the events must be executed.

## Alpe-Adria-BMX-Club Championship FINAL RANKING

The points of the 5 best riders from every club in the final ranking of the year, get counted together. The club with the highest amount of points, wins the **trophy** for the

## "Alpe-Adria-BMX-Club Championship".

If a club wins the competition 3 times, the trophy is owned by them. Otherwise, the trophy always belongs to the winner club for one year.

Categories that will be counted for the club championship:

Boys bis 8, Boys 9-10, Boys 11-12, Boys 13-14, Boys 15-16, Men 17+ OPEN, CRUISER - 29 and CRUISER 30+

For a final ranking at least 50% of the events must be executed.

## PRICES Championship (FINAL RANKING)
